As part of a larger Branding Project, this Hand-drawn Corporate Artwork, is portraying the TCB's "call to action" Slogan: "Express Your Uniqueness", featuring symbolic elements & Ornamental Typography Design, that encapsulate the essence and philosophy of TCB studio, referencing to the brand's distinctive Style and Craft Services.





This artwork is crafted in American Heritage Handwriting design style, inspired by the Gilded Age era, resembling the 1865 - 1902 Stocks and Shares, Dollar Bills, Insurance Policies & Letterheads exquisite design.

A perfectly balanced composition, with the Header, stating the Company's Name, and the Footer, as the main Descriptor, listing the Company's main Services, symmetrically positioned along the central horizontal axis, elegantly framing the Slogan, as the inner section, the most important part of the artwork.

The text's sinuous, fluid lines create the impression of a gentle breeze, carrying a balloon—with a silver and gold nib as the nacelle—toward realms of creativity, grandeur, and boundless abundance.

The title is rendered in vintage display font, featuring Old English capital letters with a 60-degree angled shade. Encased in delicate floral ornaments, symbolizing creativity and abstract thinking, it is gilded in traditional gold leaf, for the radiant essence of solar energy, masculinity and analytical reasoning.

Elegantly hand-drawn in a fluid Flourished Copperplate Script, this entire section is composed of only three continuous lines. The line establishing horizontal dominance concludes beneath the Quill, creating the illusion that the entire composition was inscribed by the balloon as it drifted past.

The balloon, designed in an exquisite Victorian style, features intricate ornaments resembling nibs tracing elegant lines, while large ovals serve as display spaces. Attached beneath as a nacelle, a silver and gold nib enhances its symbolism—gold embodying masculinity, analytical thought, and solar energy, while silver signifies intuition and abstract reasoning. Together, these elements metaphorically represent the balance between complementary forces.







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Inspired by Martin Gerlach's compositions, the capital "E" is designed in English Cursive, seamlessly flowing. Formed from Acanthus leaves, it symbolizes endurance, prosperity, and connection. At its center, three essential tools—pencil, brush, and pen—are elegantly wrapped in a silk ribbon, representing luxury, strength, and honor. A white pearl crowns the design, embodying purity, wisdom, divine inspiration, and grace.

The word Express is rendered in a refined display typeface, inspired by the distinguished design of the Legal Tender Issue (U.S. Notes) \$10 Note from 1875. Subtly reinterpreted, it features meticulously crafted gradient shadows that enhance the depth and sophistication of the letterforms, emphasizing their elegant volumes while preserving the historical essence of the original design.








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Throughout history, Oak leaves have been considered a symbol of strength, endurance, and stability. They are also associated with wisdom and knowledge, resilience, nobility, prestige, elegance, wealth and abundance. In ancient Rome, they were often associated with Jupiter, the king of gods, symbolizing power.







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The capital letter U, adorned in Acanthus Leaves symbolizing endurance, immortality, resurrection, and prosperity, stands in perfect symmetry, resembling two hands cradling a Pearl—an emblem of purity, unicity, grace, and elegance—exuding protection. Concluding in a nib, its central opening signifies a sacred conduit between the Celestial and the Earthly, allowing Divine Inspiration to flow through the Essence of the Spirit (the Pearl) and manifest through the Quill.







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The term Uniqueness is elegantly rendered in an ornate display typeface, embodying the distinguished American Heritage style. Inspired by the rare Triple Signature 1882 Gold Certificate—of which only three exist, with one in private hands—it also traces back to the 1878 Silver Certificates, among the rarest Federal Notes. This exceptional scarcity eloquently reinforces the very essence of uniqueness itself.







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Drawn in a simple, elegant, and classic Roman serif typeface, with flourished inflections and design elements characteristic of English and American typography, this section serves as the Descriptor, referring to TCB's Drawing Service and concluding the overall design. The frame flows seamlessly with classic flourishes, maintaining the composition's continuity, while the content text follows a breezy, undulating form, subtly evoking the infinity symbol.

Simetrical Descriptor Line, aligned to center, divided in the middle by the TCB Monogram, surrounded by ornamental elements, consisting in Acanthus Leaves Themed Frame, drawn in Graphite and Silver Leaf. This particular section of the artwork will be the official footer of some of the printed & online correspondence papers and letterheads, as well as the Certificates of Authentucity and more.







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The TCB Monogram consists of four key elements: a Pearl, symbolizing Divine Inspiration, Wisdom, and Elegance; an Open Book for Knowledge; the blended letters C (Creative) and B (Balloon) for balance; and a Quill, representing one of the fundamental tools of calligraphy and lettering. Inspiration, enriched by knowledge, becomes art through the quill. Encasing the design, an Acanthus motif signifies Prosperity, Relationships, Networking, and Resilience.


